How should I pray for my neighbors?

If you know their name, pray for them by name. And if we are called to love our neighbors as we love ourselves, we can start by praying for our neighbors, classmates, and co-workers, like we pray for ourselves!

Pray for their families, friendships, and health. Pray for peace instead of anxiety, joy instead of discouragement, and a sense of God's love. Pray for jobs and a sense of purpose. Pray for wisdom in decisions. Pray for the Spirit to draw them to Jesus. Pray for them as you would pray for yourself!

Other items for prayer:

- Pray for interruptions (divine appointments).
- Pray specifically for a move of God in the next generation.
- Ask God to open your eyes to His work in the lives of the people on your grid.
- Pray using scripture. Use scripture to guide your requests (Try using Ephesians 3:14-21).
- Ask the Spirit to give you an opportunity for a gospel conversation.
