How should I pray for my neighbors?

If you know their name, **pray for them by name**. And if we are called to love our neighbors as we love ourselves, we can start by praying for our neighbors, classmates, and co-workers, like we pray for ourselves!

Pray for their **families**, **friendships**, and **health**. Pray for **peace** instead of anxiety, **joy** instead of discouragement, and a sense of **God's love**. Pray for **jobs** and a sense of **purpose**. Pray for **wisdom** in decisions. Pray for the **Spirit to draw them to Jesus**. Pray for them as you would pray for yourself!

Other items for prayer:

- Pray for interruptions (divine appointments).
- Pray specifically for a move of God in the next generation.
- Ask God to open your eyes to His work in the lives of the people on your grid.
- Pray using scripture. Use scripture to guide your requests (Try using Ephesians 3:14-21).
- Ask the Spirit to give you an opportunity for a gospel conversation.
