Draw a picture of something else that you do slowly

SELAH is a word found in the Bible and it reminds us to slow down and pause. Listen to the Bible verses in the sermon. Pause and write the word “**SELAH**” on each line as you think about who God is.



Christ has come.



Christ has died.



Christ has risen.



Christ will come again.
